(1.5kg) in the horizontal position and up to 28.2 oz. (0.8kg) when in the vertical position.



CHARGING

This device contains a built-in, 1200mAh rechargeable battery. The battery should be charged before the first use and the four Rotation Time Indicators are blinking, which indicate the battery level is low. Charge the battery at least once every 3 months, even if the device has gone unused for that length of time. The Charge LED indicator will glow red during charging and will change to green when charging is complete.

OPERATION

- 1. Screw the rotator onto a tripod or other 1/4"x20 mounting device.
- 2. Attach the camera to the 1/4"x20 mounting point on the rotator.
- 3. Angle the camera as desired. Note that angles other than horizontal result in a diminished load capacity. Do not exceed the load capacity for the angle used.
- Slide the Power switch to the ON position. The DIR, 15°, and 5' indicators will illuminate to indicate that the rotator is operating properly.
- Press the Duration button to change the amount of rotation you want to achieve. You can select 15°, 30°, 45°, 60°, 90°, 180°, or 360° rotation.

- Press the R.T. button to change the amount of time that the rotator will take to achieve the angular change set in the previous step.
- 7. By default, the rotator rotates in a clockwise direction (pan from left to right). If you want it to rotate in a counterclockwise (pan from right to left), press both the Duration and R.T. buttons at the same time. The DIR indicator will be off when set for counterclockwise rotation and on when set for clockwise rotation.
- 8. Press the Start/Stop button to begin the pan/rotation.
 The Rotation Time indicator will flash, indicating that the rotator is operating.
- 9. Press the Start/Stop button at any time to halt the pan/rotation or if you wish to change the Duration and/or Rotation Time.
- 10. When finished using the rotator, slide the Power switch to the OFF position, then remove your camera and remove the rotator from the mounting point.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- Q1: The rotator's various indicator LEDs are all off, even though the power switch is in the ON position.
- A1: The internal battery needs charging. Please fully recharge the battery and try again.
- Q2: The Rotation Time indicators are all blinking.
- A2. The battery is low. Please fully recharge the battery and try again.
- Q3: The angle markings on the platter are not lined up to start.
- A3. DO NOT MANUALLY ROTATE THE PLATTER!! Instead, set the Duration for 360° and the Rotation Time for 5', then press the Start / Stop button to rotate the platter quickly. Press the Start / Stop button when the 360/0° mark lines up with the dot on the body.
- Q4: The Rotation Time indicator is blinking, but the platter does not appear to be moving.
- A4: You might have the platter set to move very slowly. Try changing the Duration to 360° and the Rotation Time to 5', to verify that the platter rotates as it should.
