Improper Operation	<ul> <li>Do not move keyboard mouse or select PC if the initial turn-on operation procedure is not completed.</li> <li>Adjust the dip switch.</li> <li>Reboot after the PC is turned off for 5 seconds later.</li> <li>Try to select other port and then switch back.</li> </ul>




