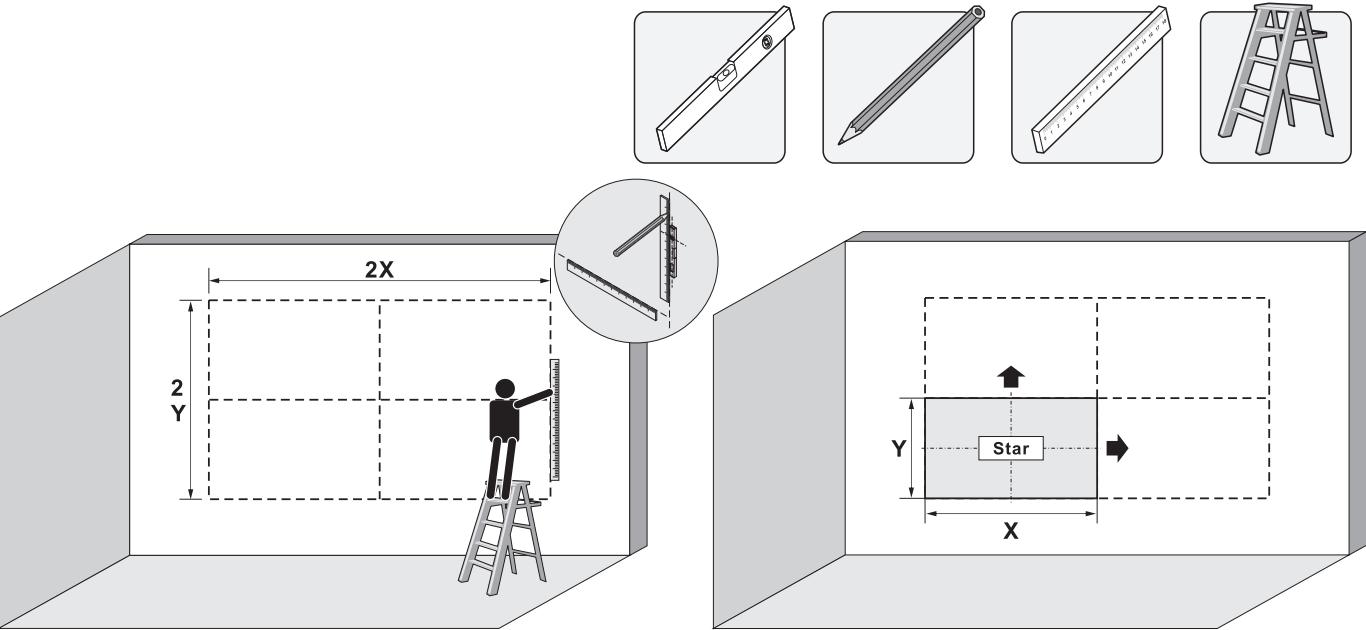

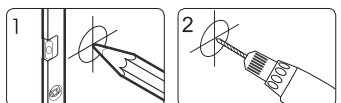
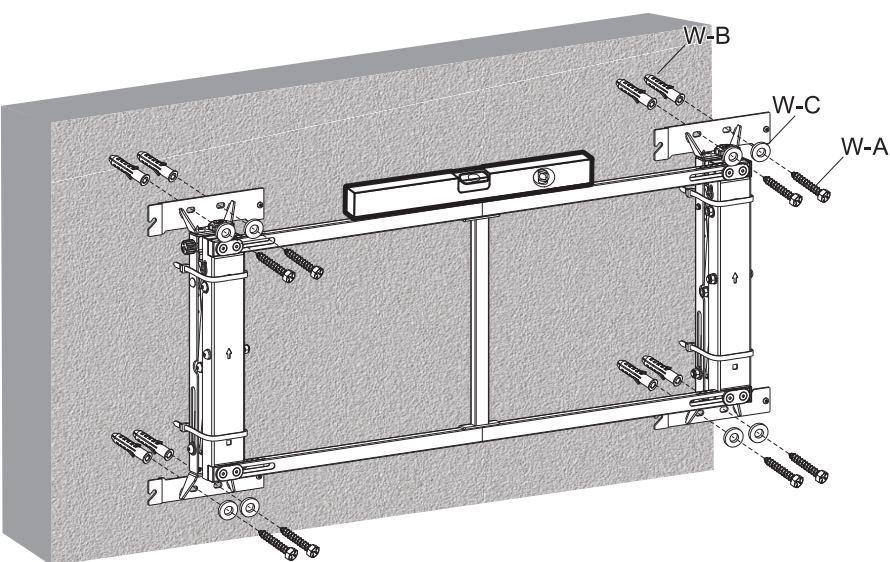
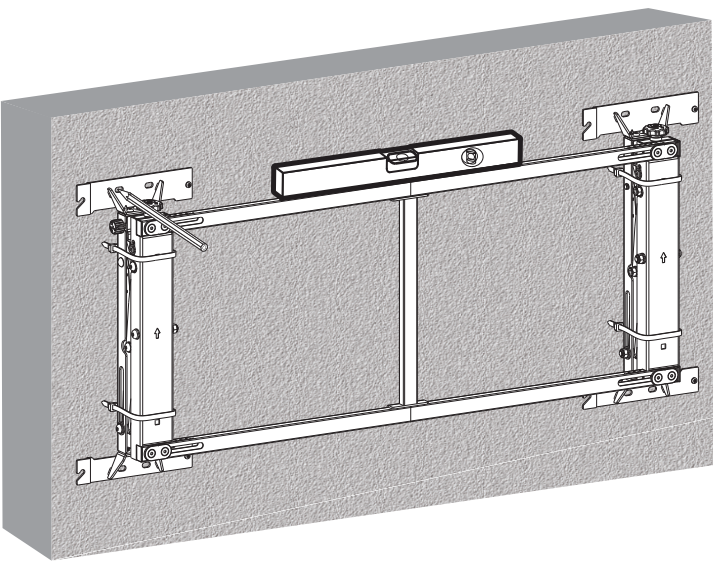
4. Video Wall Installation



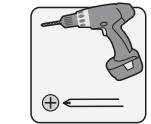
X=Length of display Y=Height of display

Mark the exact location of mounting holes



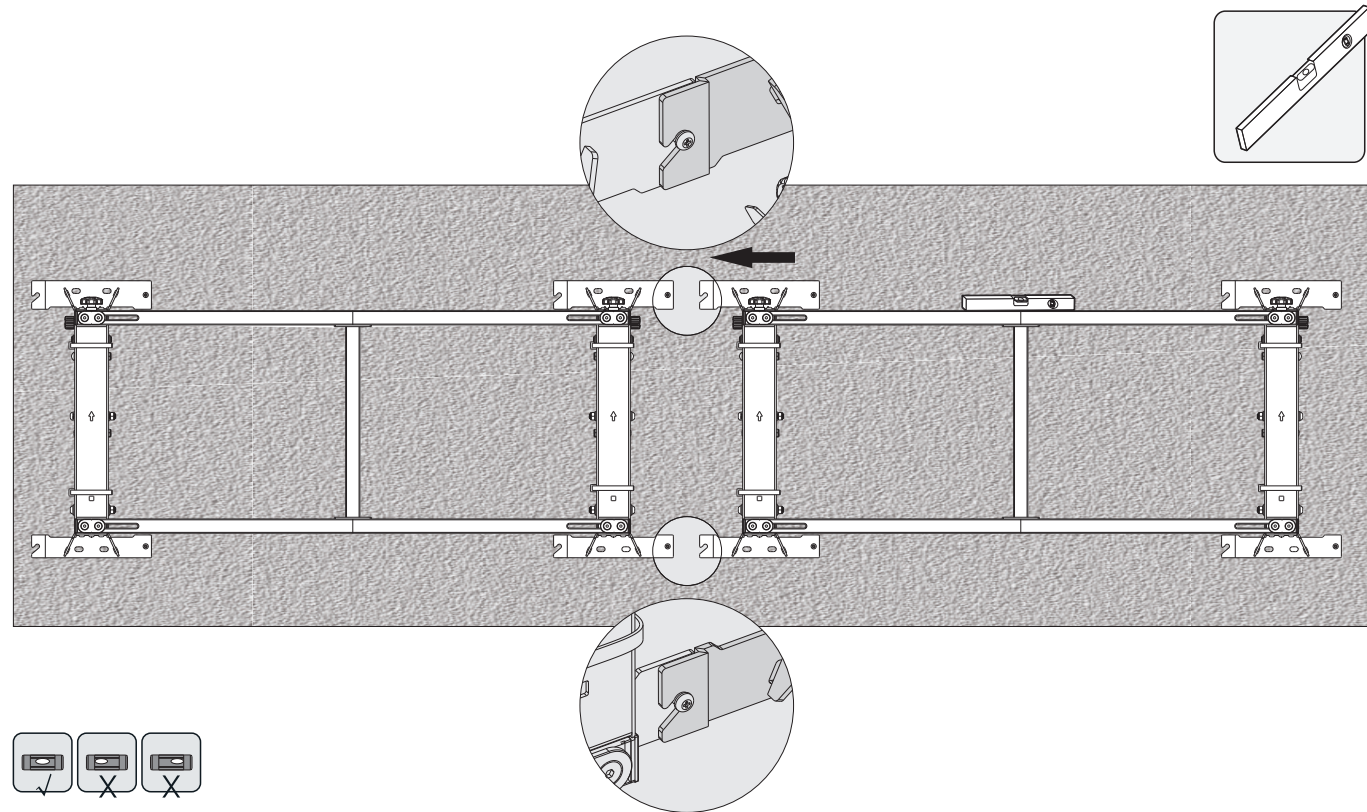

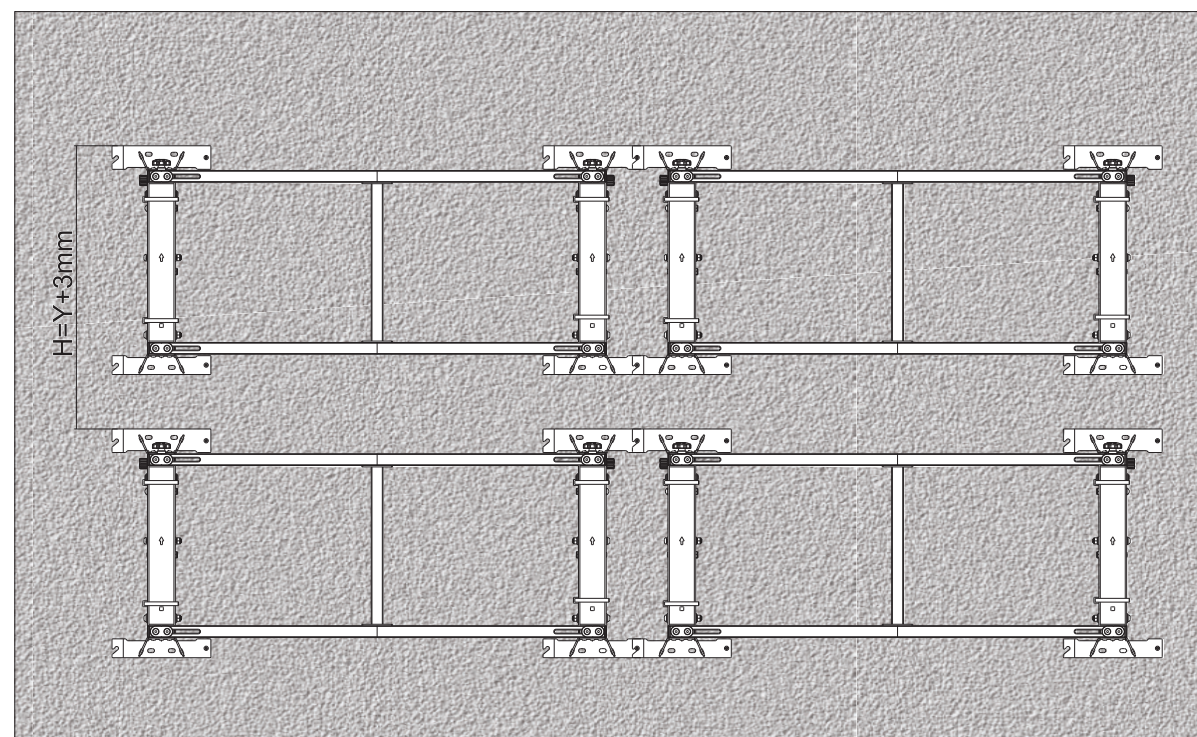

6. Connect Mounts By the Mounting Feet Slot



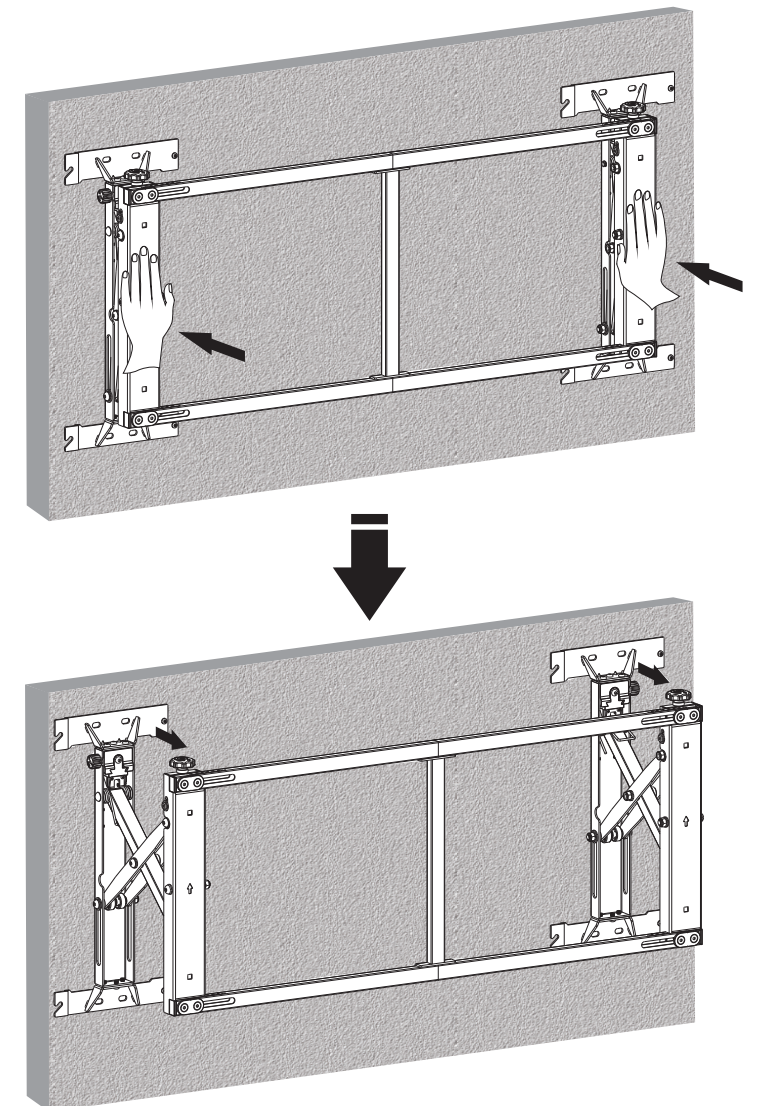
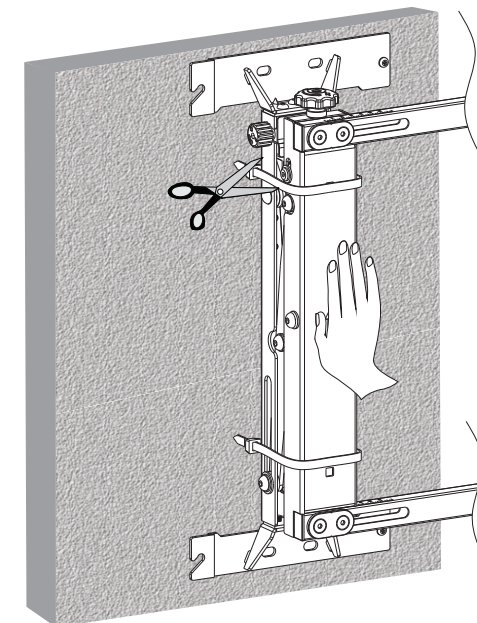
Y= TV height

H= Distance between upper and lower mount



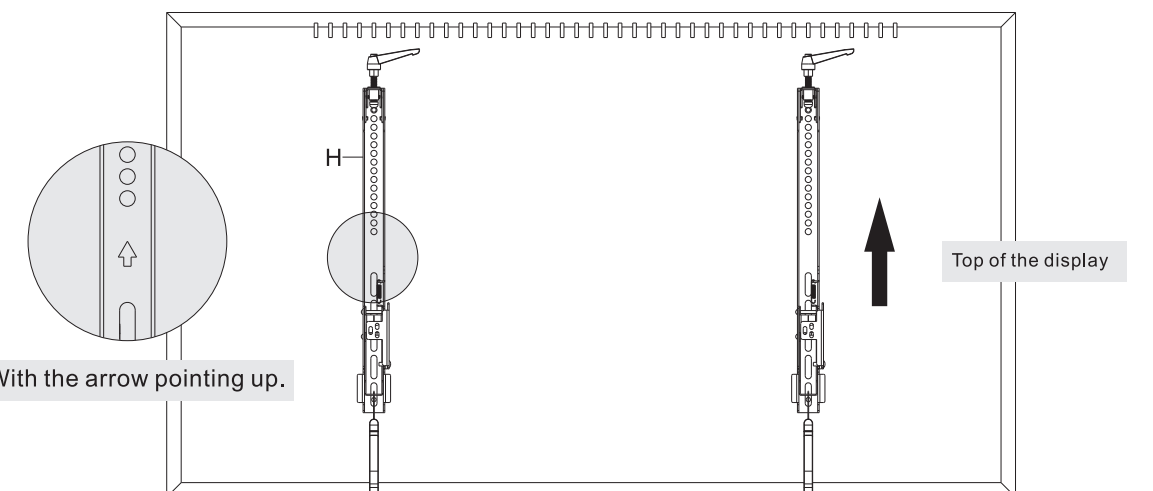
7. Pop-Out Extension

Press the arm with one hand and cut off the belt with another hand.

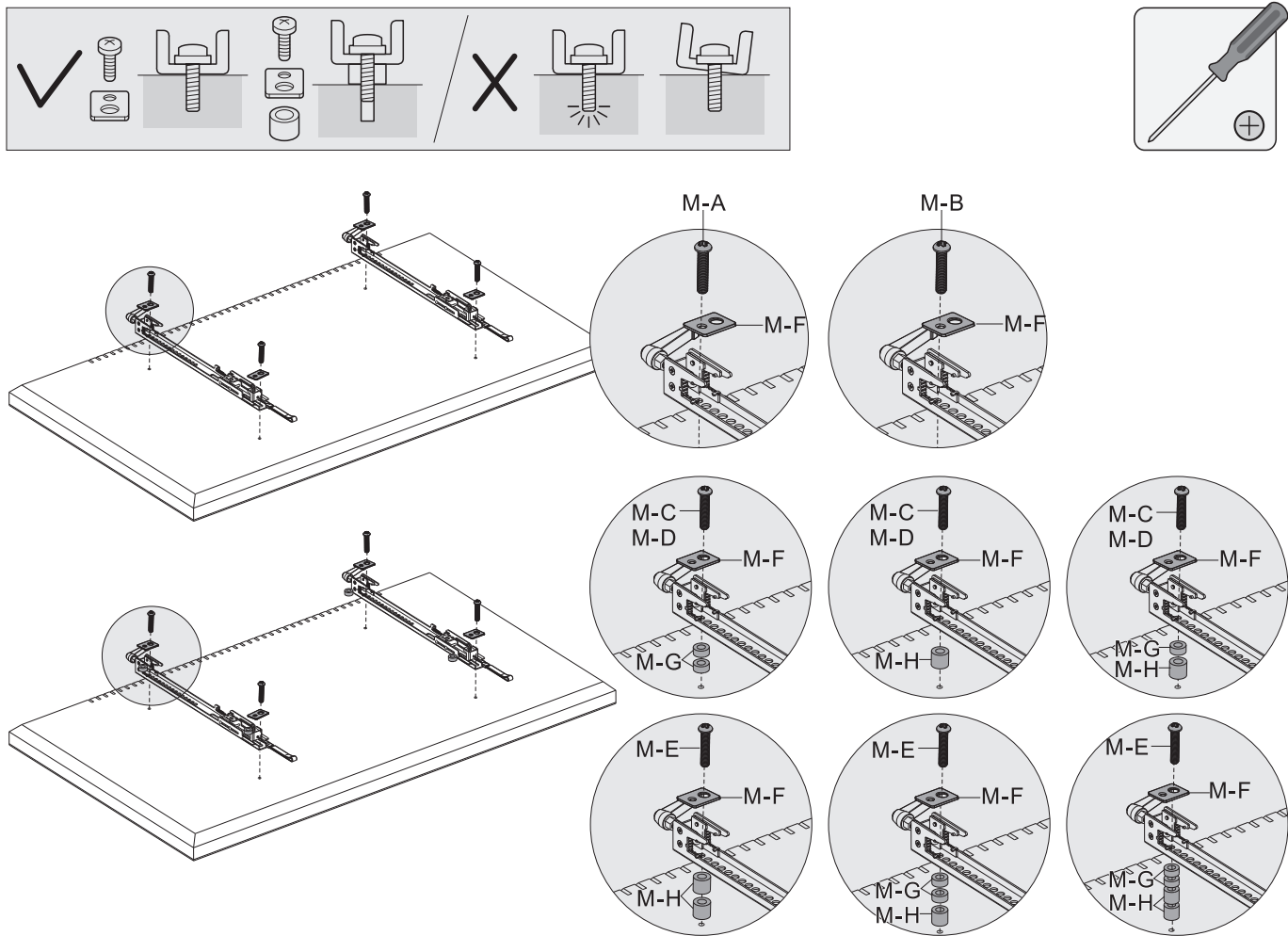


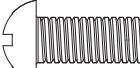
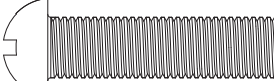
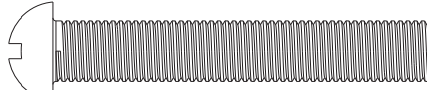
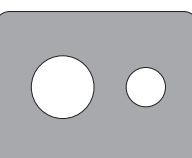
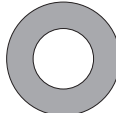
8. Attach the TV Bracket

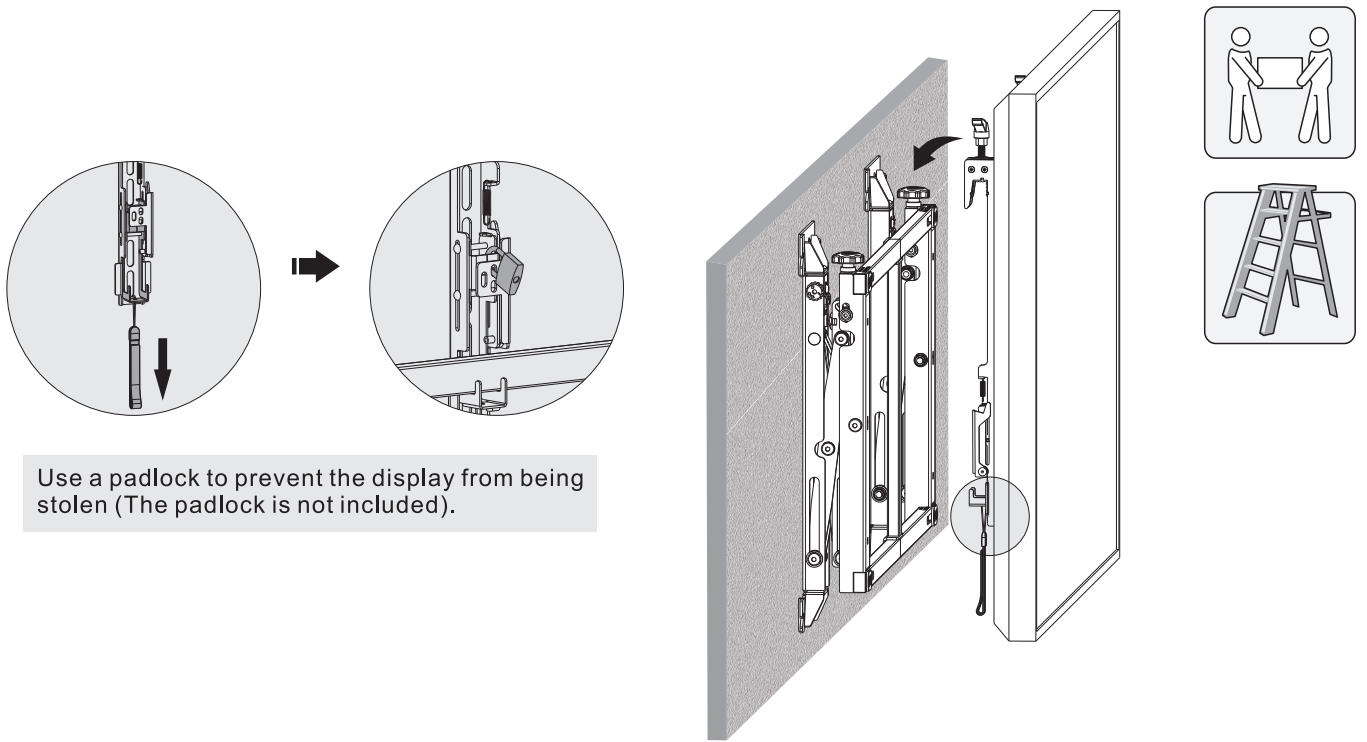

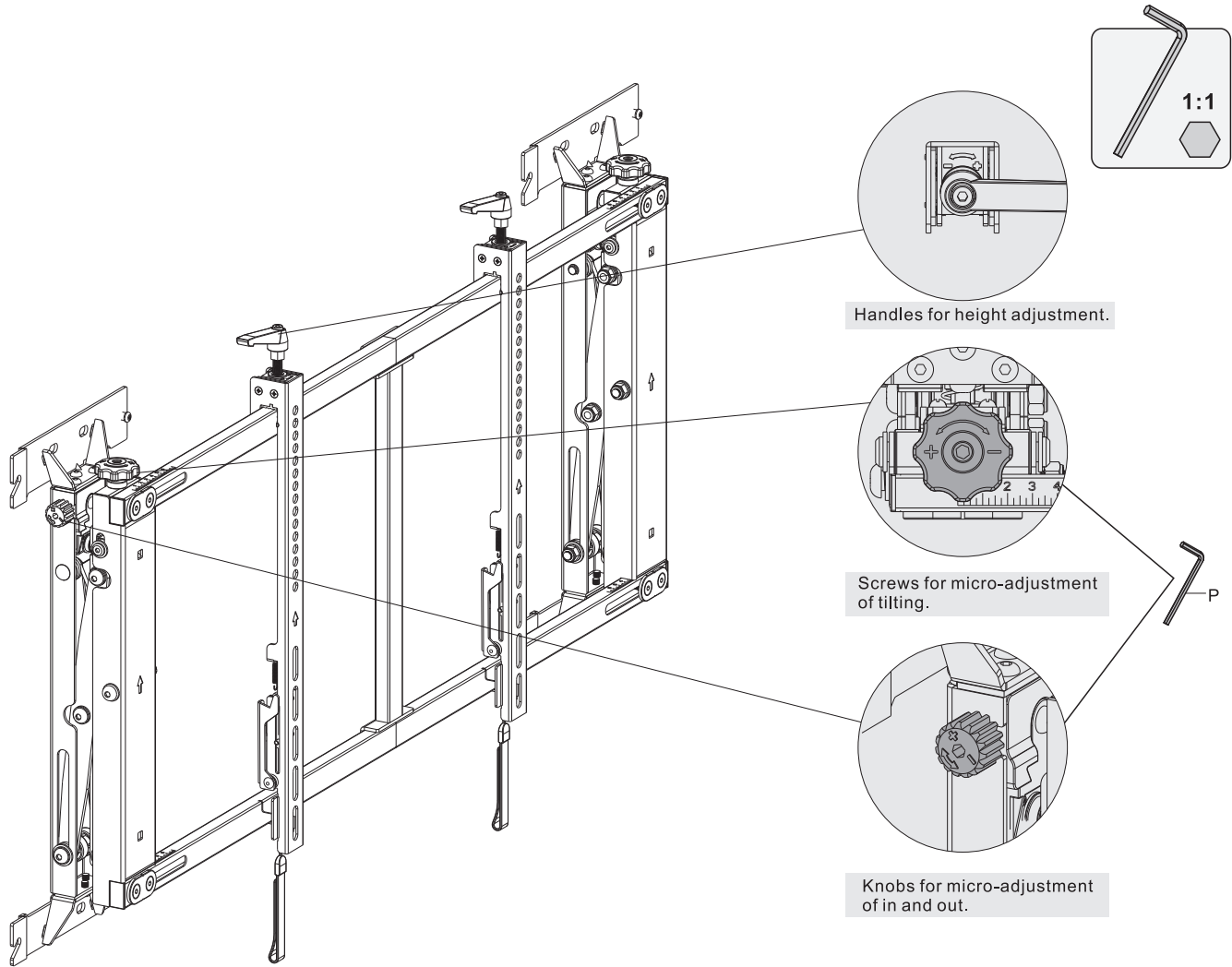

- Center the adapter brackets on the back of the display as shown, and screw the brackets onto the display, being sure to not over-tighten.

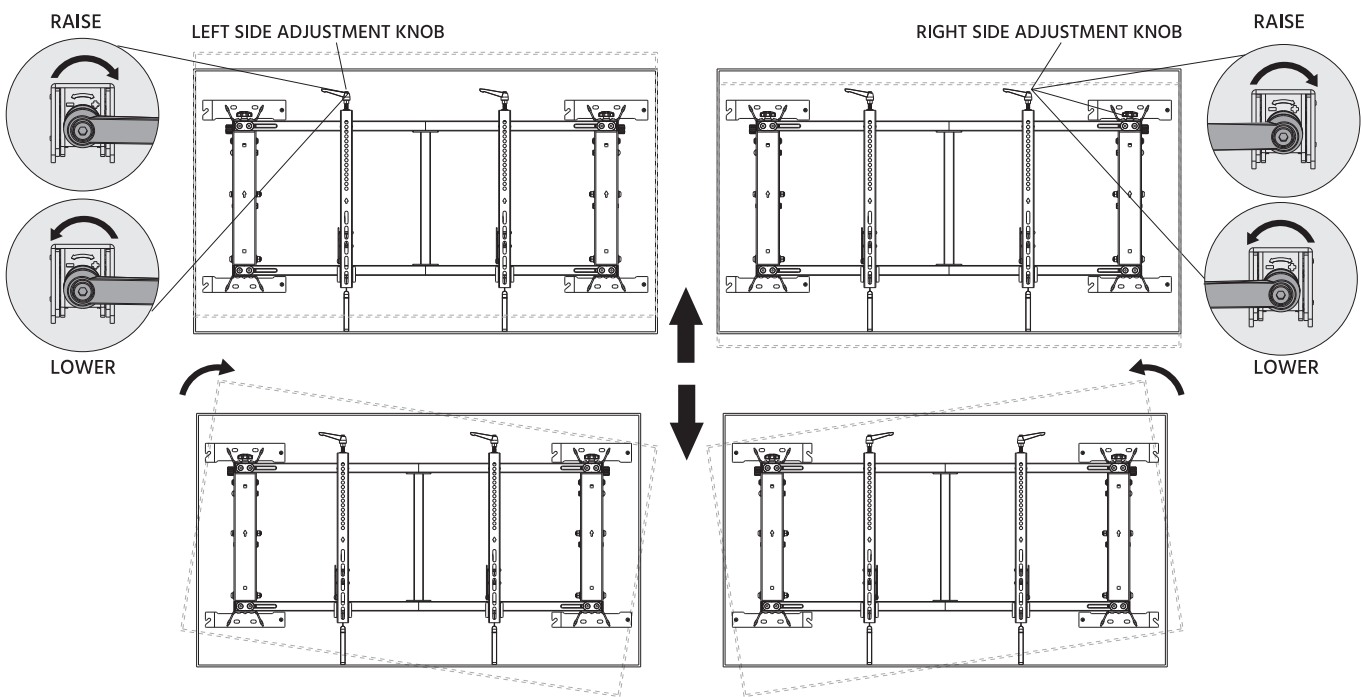

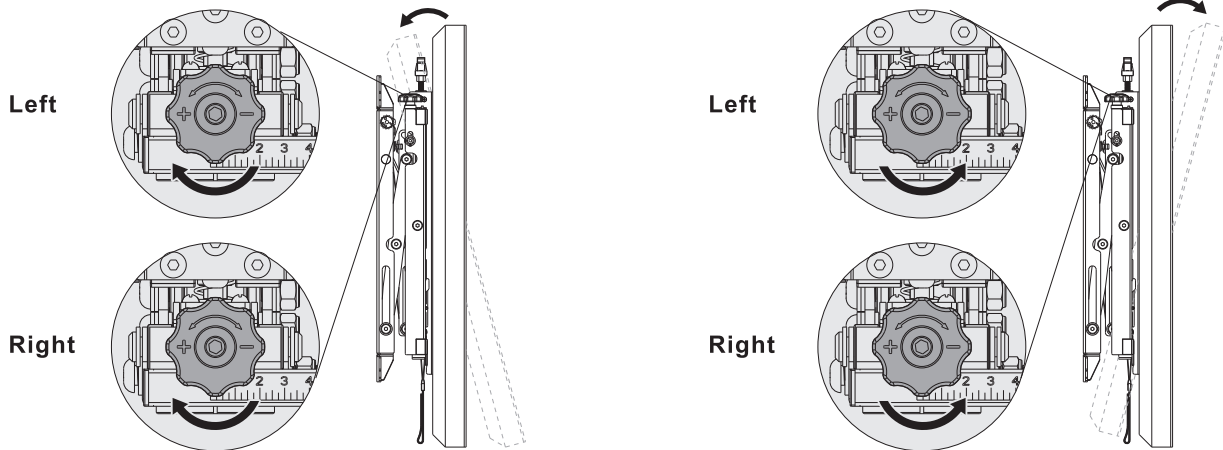


Height and Level Adjustment

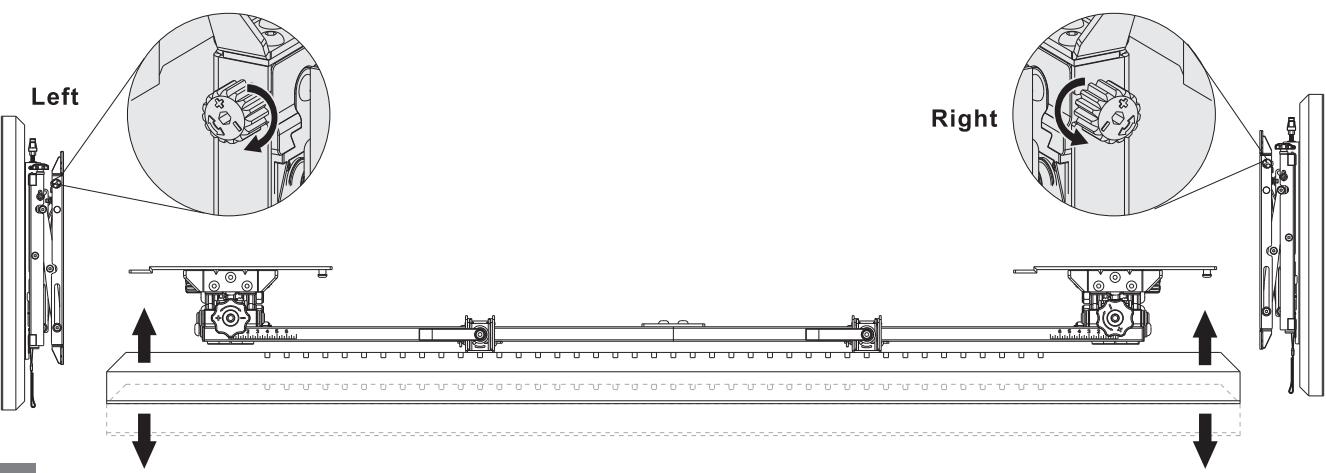


Turn the left and right knobs same amount to lift and lower the mount uniformly.
Turn the knobs individually to lift or lower one side more than the other.

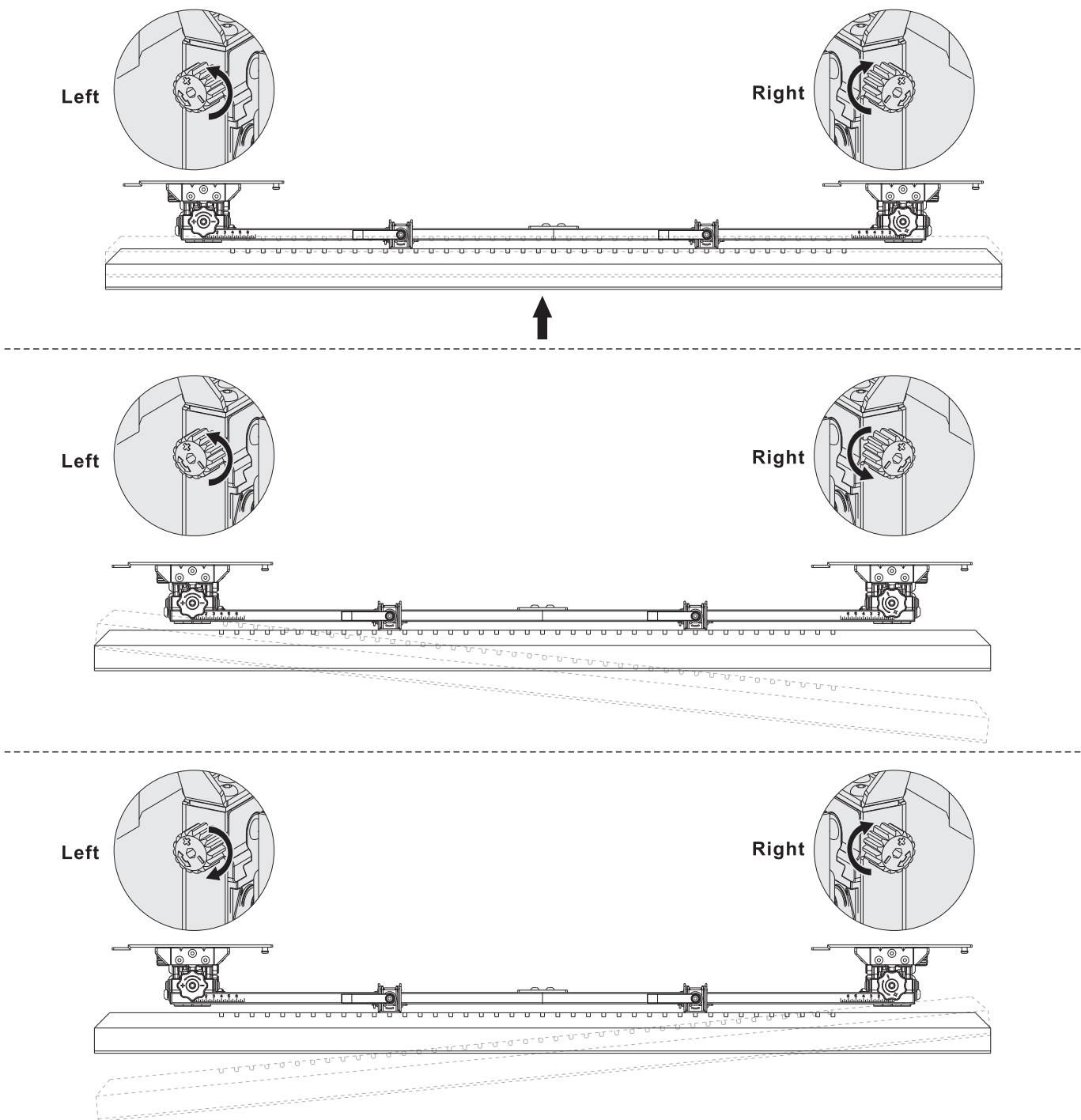
Tilt Adjustment



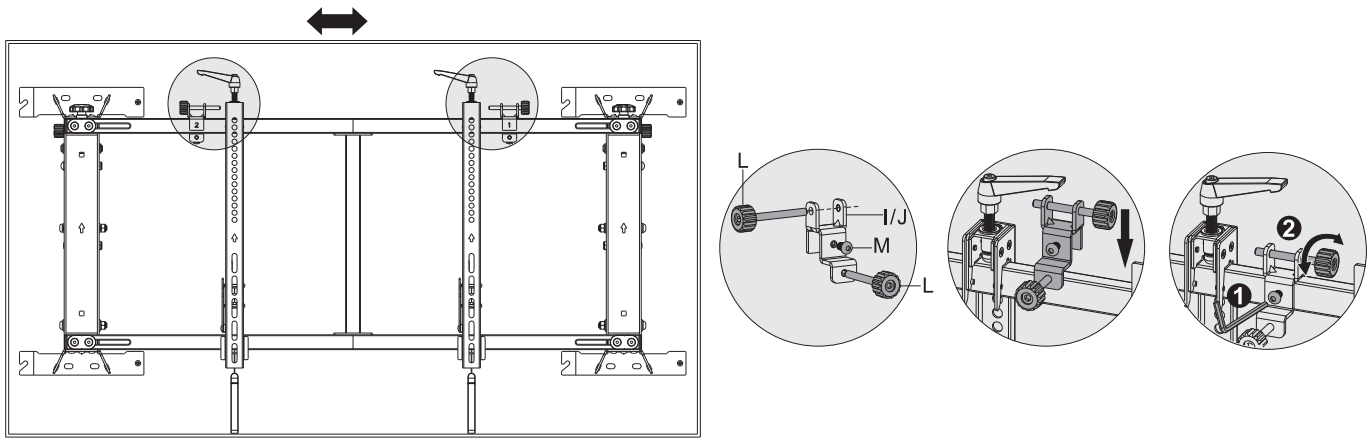
